FROM THE PULPIT LAST SUNDAY 05/06/22

Topic: Ambassadors in Bonds
Text: 2 Corinthians 5: 14 - 21; Ephesians 6: 18 - 20
Speaker: Pastor Chris Awamin

- *The early Church was faced with great persecution, yet they kept serving God even in bonds.
- *Saul was a great persecutor of Christians, he master minded the death of Steven, yet the Church never ceased to pray for him.
- *Paul as an enemy of the gospel later became an ambassador of the gospel. This was possible through the prayers of the Church.
- *Nobody can stand against the spread of the gospel. The challenges we face today as Christians is not new in the body of Christ, the early apostles also faced it yet they never gave up.
- *The life of Paul after Christ should be a challenge to us. He counted everything as loss when he became a Christian (Phil. 3: 3-8). The gospel must take everything that's not Kingdom worthy away from you.
- *The Apostles died painful deaths and lived for the sake of the Gospel. They never murmured or complained for once, this was because they had the spirit of God in them. The Apostle of old gave everything for the sake of the Gospel.
- *If Christianity does not take anything away from you, then your service to God is questionable. Paul said I counted everything all lost.
- *If you're called to serve, the mind you should have in your service to God is to draw men to the Kingdom of God
- *The Disciples of Christ went through all forms of persecution yet they never gave up, just for the sake of the Gospel. Esther said if I die, I die, if I perish I perish. This should be the mind of every believer.
- *The aim of every believer should be to make heaven, if after the suffering on earth, you still miss Heaven then you'll suffer eternally.
- *If there is anything in our lives that will not grant us access to Heaven may God take it away in Jesus name.
