### FROM THE PULPIT LAST SUNDAY 09/02/20

**Topic:** Standing Firm In The Faith Everywhere, Every time.

**Text:** Mat. 7: 24 - 29; Lk. 4: 1 - 13; Acts 10: 34 - 43; 1 Pet. 5: 8 - 11.

**Speaker:** Revd. S. O. Oladejo

The speaker emphasized that

\*Standing firm means not sleeping but a continuous action. We are to keep standing always. Standing firm is figurative, it's a state of being not just standing physically but spiritual alertness.

#### Reasons to Stand Firm

\*Storm of life will blow: It is certain that storms will come, as a Christian we will have storms of various forms in our lives (Matt. 7: 24-29).

\*Satan is attacking: It is the duty of the devil to always attack those who stand in the faith (Luk. 4: 1 - 13, 1 Pet. 5: 8-11).

\*Satan uses what we need most to tempt us, he used food to tempt Jesus in the wilderness when he was hungry.

\*Because Jesus Himself stood firm: Standing firm in the faith means knowing the word of God and standing by it. (Act 10:38). Our faith develop by studying the Word of God. Not standing firm on the word of God means you are likely to fail.

\*Jesus is our perfect example of standing firm.

\*God will be with you if you stand firm without compromising.

\*Psalm 1: 1-6 shows an example of the life of someone standing firm in the faith.

\*The question to ask yourself is are you standing firm in the faith in your Family?

\*It is the duty of every Christian to stand firm in the faith in their Family, School, Place of work etc....

\*A Christian should not be standing firm only in the Church, but every where we find ourselves.

\*There is nothing like anointing oil, it is oil for anointing (Exo. 30: 22-33)

\*When we come to the Church, except there is an interpreter let no one speak in tongues (1 Cor. 14: 23-28).

\*We should not copy people blindly, we should only copy what is in line with the Bible.

**Conclusion:** Not standing firm in the faith means falling down or death. Let us stand firm in the faith through the help of the power of the Holy Spirit. If you don't stand by the word of God you will fall and falling means you will miss Heaven.
