Topic: Marks of Spiritual Maturity

Text: Hebrews 5: 1-14

God Expects You To Mature

*Maturity is the expectation of every parent for their children.
 *God expects and commands spiritual maturity from his children. He told Abraham to walk before him and be blameless.

Misunderstanding Spiritual Maturity

*Spiritual maturity does not necessarily mean your chronological or spiritual age. Neither is it about appearance, spiritual gifts nor speaking in tongues.

Understanding Spiritual Maturity

*Spiritual maturity is a journey to becoming like Jesus. It is when your languages and understanding of spiritual things have changed (1 Cor. 13:11).
 *Spirituality brings you to the point you stop thinking that until you hold the microphone you can not contribute to the things of God.
 *Spiritual maturity is when you have overcome temptations that you once fell for (1 Jn. 2:14). Being mature in the deeper things of the gospel (Heb. 5:14).
 *Spiritual maturation is when you come to the full knowledge and stature of Christ.
 *It also means that we can no longer be tossed to and fro by every wind of doctrine (Eph. 4:14). It is learning to take the things of God personally instead of running to others to ask for help on spiritual matters, first take it to God.
 *Letting the Holy Spirit be your number one helper.
 *Spiritual maturity means becoming a stake holder in the Kingdom matters (2 Cor. 5:19).

Marks of Spiritual Maturity

1. When situations no longer negatively affect your relationship with God e.g. political situations, economic situations etc. The storms of life no longer affect your confidence in God (Rom. 8: 35-37).
2. Your spiritual senses are exercised to discern both good and bad (Heb. 5:44) if your eyes or any of the senses controls you, you are still a baby. You are to train your senses on how they should function, they should not have control over you.
3. Allowing God train your senses to make you a mature Christian and to function effectively both physically and spiritually.
