FROM THE PULPIT LAST SUNDAY 05/10/25 Topic: Winning on every side Text: Genesis 22:16-18; I Corinthians 15:57 Speakers: Pastor Toyin Balogun • To win means to conquer, to reach your destination, to achieve a particular goal irrespective of the obstacles. • In the journey of life, there are obstacles. You must be determined to overcome the obstacles. • The race we are to win is the one marked out for each of us, so it is not a competition. • To win this race, we must fix our eyes on Jesus who is the author of it (Hebrew 12:2). • There are three major obstacles on this journey which are self, the world and the devil. • There’s a reward for everyone who wins the race. • Many desire to enjoy the benefits of winning but are not ready to pay the price of running the race. • A follower of Jesus will face challenges just as Abraham also faced famine (Gen 12:10) • If you walk by the flesh just as Lot did, you’ll fall into the hands of the devil and destruction is the end. • Abraham also faced the challenge of barrenness on his journey and he won because God helped him.. • Abraham grew in accordance with God’s will and was able to control his appetite. • Christ has already won this race for us, we’re to be in Him to be able to enjoy this victory. • For us to win on every side, we must remain focused on Jesus.		OPERATION WORLD Georgia Capital: Tbilisi The official languages of Georgia are Georgian and Abkhaz within the autonomous region of Abkhazia. The population of Georgia is estimated at 4,469,200 and 83.9%) of them practice Orthodox Christianity Religious minorities of Georgia include Armenian Christians (3.9%), Muslims (9.9%), and Roman Catholics (0.8%).
