Oyedepo Text: Gen. 22:17; 1 Chron. 9:17-24; Ps. 24:7-10 Speakers: Possessing The Family Gates</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Family is the primary nucleus of society. Acts as a school of love, shaping the moral, social and emotional character of the next generation. * Family failure results in failure of society. * Gate is a place of entry or exit - a symbol of power and authority. * Types of gates: - personal, family, church, community and nation. * Family gate can be under satanic control. * Generational curses include sickness, poverty, divorce, untimely deaths, delays, barrenness etc., along the bloodline. * God desires that family gates be open continually for blessings, favour and divine encounters. (Isaiah 60:11) * Gates require gatekeepers. * Each of us is a gatekeeper for our families holding the keys to open or close. * Gatekeeper must protect and defend family through prayers of intercession to take over gates from the enemy. * Must be alert, strong and courageous. (1 Peter 5:8-9). * Gatekeeper must know God and seek His leading. * Gatekeepers must monitor their children, supervise, guide, guard and lead them to Christ. * Then God will be pleased with you as He was with Abraham in (Gen.18:19). * Our youths should, through prayers, thoroughly investigate the family of the would-be partners they intend to marry. 		<p style="text-align: center;">OPERATION WORLD</p> <p>Kenya Capital: Nairobi Kenya has a young population, with 73% of residents aged below 30 years due to rapid population growth; from 2.9 million to 40 million inhabitants over the last century. It has two official languages, English and Swahili. As high as 83% of Kenyans are Christian (47.7% Protestant, 23.5% Roman Catholic. & 621,200 Orthodox Christians). Let's pray that the gains in Kenya would not be lost. That the Lord will bring a revival to the land that will draw the rest of the population to the knowledge of Christ and prepare His people for the second coming of Jesus.
