Pray for fruitfulness in the mission fields and in the lives of all missionaries there. <p align="center">OPERATION WORLD</p> <p>Kazakhstan Capital: Astana Official estimates of the population of Kazakhstan is 16.5 million. About 70.2% of the population is Muslim, 26.6% are Christians, 0.1% are Buddhists, 0.2% belong to other religions (mostly Jews), and 2.8% non-believers, while 0.5% chose not to answer.</p> <p>Pray that a large number of Kazakhstanis will be reached for Jesus and that the Lord will send labourers into the land. Ask that the light of Christ will prevail over the gross darkness in the people's hearts.</p> <p align="center">Praying for Nigeria: Abia State</p> <p>About 3.8m people living in Abia State are predominantly Christians, mainly Catholics. There are also some Anglicans and Pentecostals as well as Muslims in the State. Pray that God will save the people of Abia State from empty religion and turn them to true believers.
