Topic: Standing Firm In The Faith BY Disciplined Dedicated Discipleship Text: Joshua 14: 1–15

Speaker: Pastor Ayo Okeowo.

*The Speaker emphasized that:

*Being diligent in small things will give you the opportunity to handle big things too diligently. *David had the opportunity of killing Saul but he never took law into his hands, he allowed God to avenge him. Stop fighting your battles yourself, let God be your defense.

*We need to know our God to be able to go through difficult times. The mercies of God are new every morning, great is Hisfaithfulness.

*Let us continue to examine ourselves to be sure we are standing in the faith. Walking with God is a systematic process, we have to keep walking with Him every time.

*God is calling us to follow holiness and righteousness without which no man shall see God. We are bought with a price, we must therefore honour God with all our body.

*If you want to be a disciple of Jesus, you have to continually follow His steps. We are called to be disciplined, devoted and follow the master.


