<p style="text-align: center;"><u>FROM THE PULPIT LAST SUNDAY 01/02/26</u></p> <p>Topic Bondservant of Christ Text: Romans 1:8-15, Exodus 21:1-2, 4(1-6), Judges 1:12-13, 3:10 Speaker: Pastor Henry Owolabi</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Release yourself to be used by God. * Be in the body of Christ as someone who knows why he/she was saved. * As a believer/child of Christ, you are not saved to be a bench warmer or onlooker. * God didn't make you a leader to serve yourself, but to serve him. * Are you ready to run errands for God as Paul served him wholly? Romans 1:9-10 * If God so loved and died for us, we should be inspired to do more for God. * We should serve others with the gifts, wisdom and strength that God has given us. * When working for God, you are not doing Him a favour. * In Exodus 21, it is shown that a bond servant willingly agrees to serve his master for life even though by law he had been set free. * Paul, who had been set free by Jesus also chose to be a bondservant by his free choice. * Those of us whom Christ has saved and called to serve him should commit ourselves to be bondservants to him.. * The same way Othniel served as the first judge by risking his life to engage a king whose name means double wickedness who had troubled Israel for 8 years. * Othniel demonstrated humility, patience, courage, faith and dependence on the Holy Spirit just as David in the OT and Paul in the NT. 		<p style="text-align: center;">OPERATION WORLD</p> <p>Israel Capital: Jerusalem Israel's population is about 8m, of whom about 6m are Jews. a social survey for those over the age of 20 indicates that 55% say they are "traditional", while 20% consider themselves "secular Jews", 17% define themselves as "Religious Zionists"; 8% define themselves as "Haredi Jews". Making up 16% of the population, Muslims constitute Israel's largest religious minority. About 2% of the population are Christian and 1.5% are Druze.</p> <p>Let's pray that the plan of God for the Jews would be accomplished and that they will accept Jesus as the Savior sent from God. Pray for the peace of Jerusalem.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Praying for Nigeria: Rivers State</p> <p>Rivers State, with a population of 7m people, is made up of the Ikwerre, Ijaw, Kalabari, Okrika, Ibani, Etche, Ogba, Ekpeye, Ndoki, Ogoni and other people. In Rivers State where more than 20 languages are spoken, is predominantly Christian with a presence of traditional worshippers and minority Muslims.
