**Topic: Handling Relationship Abuse in Contemporary Times  
Text: 2 Corinthians 5 : 13 - 21.

- \*It is very important to discuss about relationship abuse and understand how to handle them especially in the body of Christ - Prevention is better than cure.
- \*Relationship is simply connections or associations and abuse is improper treatment or usage. Abuse is any action done intentionally with the aim of hurting someone.
- \*Abuse can be done by anyone, it can be from parents to children, from husband to wife or the other way round. Abuses have significant spiritual consequences.
- \*Relationship abuse affects every area of life. The Bible says that offenses are bound to come but woe unto him by whom they come.
- \*Sin is the root source of relationship abuse. God's creation exists on relationship, it is the original plan of God for us to be in a relationship with one another. Money can also cause relationship abuse.
- \*Types of Abuse : Child abuse, which is usually done by those who are close to the child. Domestic violence, which is very common in Nigeria. Spiritual Abuse, using Scriptures to manipulate someone is also a form of abuse. Verbal Abuse i.e use of abusive languages, name calling e.t.c

**Prevention**

- \*Be educated and aware of what constitute abuse.
- \*Try to defeat abuse by watching out for the signs that someone is being abused.
- \*Do not overlook abuse, learn to deal with it.
- \*Let the victims talk about it, don't blame them or shut them up.
- \*Your inability to control your anger is also a sign of mental illness.
- \*Men suffers more of emotional or verbal abuse while women suffers more of physical abuse.

- \*Love everyone like Christ did and operate with Biblical standards in your daily living
- \*Don't be unequally yoked with an unbeliever.
- \*Parents should live exemplary lives for their to emulate.
