Topic: A Sacrifice of Praise
Text: 2 Peter 2: 1 — 12.
Speakers: Mr. Mayowa Gidado

- *Cain and Abel story teaches that the worshipper comes first before his worship, service or sacrifice. Gen 4
- *The starting point is to settle the fact that praise and worship is the end not the means. We sing, we use instruments and all, to enable us worship. They are not the worship. Worship should be unending and continual.
- *It is what our whole lives are about. It should be without ceasing and involves our whole being ; all we are and have. Ex 10:24
- *The reason why we gather is to continually unpack the contents of the covenant God had enacted with His son and which we are beneficiaries of. This covenant is inexhaustible and as we unpack it more and more, our depth of worship deepens.
- *Worship is acknowledging and ascribing the ownership and lordship of all things to the one who owns it and is Lord. In another sense, it is to lay prostrate, bow face down, fall down, to pay homage and pay respect out of reverence.
- *Praise means to sing, to tell of, to give or to confess or declare the goodness of a person. It means to be thankful for God's blessings, and to declare that blessing to God and to others. God inhabits my praise, Praise awaits you oh God in Zion.

Ingredients/Components of Praise and Worship

1. Knowledge of God (experiential and revelation). Your worship is limited by your knowledge. You worship to the extent of what you know.
2. Gratitude and appreciation - Moses and Miriam after crossing the red sea expressed their gratitude. Exo.15.
3. Overwhelming emotion. Mary and the alabaster box. Matt 26:6-13.
4. Faith - standing on our conviction (that He is worthy of all praise, that He's all powerful). This we see in the life of the 3 Hebrew children, also when David faced Goliath, he didn't say I come to you with my sling and I'm good at it, he said I come in the name of the Lord, that's worship as spiritual warfare
5. Worship must be in spirit and in truth. Jn. 4:23-24, Is 29 :13.
- *In Conclusion let us continue to refresh our minds and our hearts with whom our God is and He will continue to reveal Himself to us.
