<div>FROM THE PULPIT LAST SUNDAY 08/06/25</div> <div>Topic: Sowing And Reaping</div> <div>Text: Psalm 126</div> <div>Speakers: Pastor Henry Owolabi</div> <div><div>• God is reminding us that we are still “work in progress”, and He desires to bring us to the expected end.</div><div>• God is sowing into our lives, and He expects to see results.</div><div>• The Word of God is what has been sown in our lives.</div><div>• In John 3:16, God invested His only begotten Son in our lives so that we might be saved.</div><div>• Sowing and reaping is a principle of God.</div><div>• When God made man, He sowed His word into him: “Be fruitful and multiply” and God’s children are also called to operate by this principle of sowing, fruitfulness and multiplication.</div><div>• Everyone who sows expects a return—and likewise, God expects a return from our lives, since he has invested his only begotten Son.</div><div>• If you sow in tears, you will reap in joy.</div><div>• Many people have problem with sow because they are running away from the tears that accompany it such as preoccupation with the thoughts of what to eat, wear, or drink (Matthew 6:31–32).</div><div>• Some people also have problem with trusting God and holding him by his words, they are not ready to sow their faith and so for reasons of unbelief do not sow.</div><div>• God needs you more than your money: He is not looking for your money—He is looking for you</div><div>• If you seek the Lord, you are sowing: therefore seek to know him, seek to please him, seek to know/do his will, seek to please him and let him be pleased with you, and so you walk worthy of the Lord.</div></div>		<div>MISSIONS PRAYER FOCUS FOR JUNE, 2025</div> <div><div>1.
