Topic: Our God Is Worthy Of Continual Worship
Text: Psalm 34: 1-22.

- *We tend to associate the worship of God to only joyous occasions, but the praise and adoration of God should be continual (Psalm 34).
- *Worshipping our God should not be a once in a while occasion but a continual process at all times as we are alive.
- *Only reflective and deep thinkers would see reasons at all times (difficult, pleasurable, worrisome, restful, hurtful and even painful occasions).
- *There is no denying the fact that we can be sad, in need, wounded, distressed, but those who know their God shall be strong in praise and do exploit (Rom. 5:1-5)
- *We worship the God of the mountains, in the valley, at night and day. Our praise should be continual.
- *Like Uriah, Naboth and other heroes of the scripture we should be resolute in the face of persecution, injustice etc. our faith must not fail as we resound in praise and worship (Heb.11: 36-50).
