FROM THE PULPIT LAST SUNDAY 12/10/25 Topic: God's provision for our fruitfulness Text: Genesis 6:1 -8; Galatians 5:16-25 Speakers: Bro Lanre Ajayi • There is a deposit of God's spirit in us that makes us to be like Him in living, nature and operation. • God’s intention was to redeem man back to Himself when he fell. That is the reason why he makes provision for the redemption of mankind. • The purpose of God for creating man is to be fruitful and multiply. • Man was still multiplying when he fell into sin but at that time, his multiplication wasn't giving glory to God. They were multiplying as it pleased them. • Initially, God gave a wife to Adam but when man fell, they began to choose wives for themselves (Genesis 6:2). • A man who has not been regenerated will always be in contention with anything godly. • If God said that the wickedness of man was great at that time, according to Genesis' account, what will he say about man's wickedness today? OPERATION WORLD Germany Capital: Berlin Germany consists of 16 states with Berlin as the capital and largest city . With 81.8 million inhabitants, it is the most populous member state and the largest economy in the European Union. Christianity is the largest religion in Germany, with around 51.5 million (62.8%) adherents in 2008. Of this, 30.0% are Catholics and 29.9% are Protestants. The second largest religion is Islam with an estimated 3.8 to 4.3 million adherents (4.6% to 5.2%), followed by Buddhism with 250,000 and Judaism with around 200,000 adherents (0.3%); Hinduism has some 90,000 adherents (0.1%). Christian church membership has decreased in recent decades, particularly among Protestants. Germany is in serious need of God's intervention as there is a sharp decline in Church attendance and Godliness. There are still true believers standing firm for the Lord. Let's pray the Lord send revival to the land and turn the heart of the people to Him. Praying for Nigeria: Imo State Imo State has a population of 5.1 million people comprising a Christian.
