FROM THE PULPIT LAST SUNDAY 18/09/22

Topic: The Church & Politics in Nigeria
Text: Matthew 5: 13-16; Romans 13: 1-7.

1st Speaker: Dr. Sola Ajolore

- *Politics is concerned with how power is acquired and used in a country or in an organization. Politics generally entails decision making.
 - *The Church is there to condemn anything that is making life difficult for people.
 - *It is the duty of the Church to cry against injustice and bad government. But the Church in Nigeria is not speaking against bad government.
 - *There is nothing that is happening in this country (Nigeria) that is not traceable to the 1999 fraud, that is that 1999 constitution. It is a document that lies against itself according to Late Rotimi Williams. Afe Babalola calls it "the problem of Nigeria".
 - *The constitution has given freedom to bandits and favours one religion over the others. It is like a knocked Engine. Amending it will not change anything, it has to be changed for this country to move forward.
 - *Christians who are in public services should learn to help other Christians to public positions. In our little corners let's help to put Christians to positions where they can also serve effectively.
 - *Politics is not a dirty game, it is because we have allowed bad people to play it in Nigeria that's why it is a dirty game. If the foundation (1999 constitution) is faulty what can the righteous do? (Ps. 11:3).
 - *Jesus said watch and pray. But we are only praying and not watching.

- *All the arms of government (Executive, Legislative and Judiciary) work together to provide security of life and properties, to provide good governance
 - *Some of the limitations faced by Participants in political offices is the use or abuse of money, no matter how excellent your ideas are, if money doesn't flow you are on your own.
 - *When tugs, armed robbers are being paid by the government to carry out illegal activities so as to protect their political interest.
 - *Christians should join politics so as to be able to influence decision making and to protect their interest. The more you are the greater your chances of effecting change in the system.
 - *The impacts of a Christian in politics is dependent on the crowd he has. If Christians want to have impacts or influences, they must join politics and stand with those who are representing them in government
 - *A Christian in government must never compromise in doing evil. A lot of those in politics don't have good principles to be good representatives to the Church.
