Topic : Overcoming Offence: Perspectives For The Offender And The Offended Text : Luke 17 : 1 ; Galatians 5 : 13 - 26

*Reioice in the Lord always is not for everyone but for the believer.

- *Offence is an emotional displease; it is a trap from Satan to rob us of our peace.
- *Offence is deeply rooted in the fallen human nature.
- *Offence is rooted in self; offences may be against God and our fellow man.

*There are offences both in the home, work place, Church etc.

- *Every one of us is an offender until we come to God and repent of our sins.
- *Every disobedience to God is an offence unto God, When we rebel against God we are committing offence against God.

*When you carry false information against someone it is also form of offence.

- *Joseph's brothers offended him, but God turned it to good for him. *Offences causes displeasure and can also lead to distrust.
- *Offences can take us lower than we are to be when we give room to it.

*Offences stems from selfishness.

*We should learn to give room to people to explain themselves.

*Offence is a matter of the heart, we should always plead to God to help our hearts.

*Offence can also stem from lack of good communicate or misunderstanding. *Once there is a barrier between you and man, there will be a barrier between you and God. *We can restore relationship when we give rooms for offences and forgive people. We should

surrender to Jesus.

*We must make sure our flesh has been crucified (Galatians 5 :24).

*We should not pay evil for evil but pay evil with good as Christians (Romans 12:21). *When we are abused or offended, God will be watching the offended not really the offender to see what the offended will do

*The old life is automatic; but the new life in Christ we have to learn to live it.

*The object of our faith is Christ: we should always ask ourselves at every point what will Jesus do?

*Respect must be two ways.

*We should be fore bearing towards one another (Colossians 3:13-14).

*Some of the practical steps to resolve conflicts is that we can go to the person and speak with the person, if the person doesn't accept then you can involve the elders in the Church (Matthew 18:15)
