**FROM THE PULPIT LAST SUNDAY 08/05/22**

**Topic:** Followers of Christ

**Text:** Matthew 4: 18 - 22; 7: 21-28; 1 Corinthians 11:1.

\*Peter among the other disciples was the most outstanding who showed more interest in following Christ.

\*Peter was so addicted to Christ, yet he ended up denying Christ three times.

\*We are to take heed when we are following Christ if not we may later deny him just as Peter did.

\*Some people are still in Church but are afar off as Peter was in Matt. 26:58.

\*If we are not careful and keep watch we may be afar off from Christ yet we may never acknowledge it.

**Why Do People Keep Far Off From Following Jesus**

1. Prevalence of sin (Matt. 24:12): When sin is prevalent in your life, you'll be far from Jesus. It is so unfortunate that we're in a generation where we celebrate sin. It should not be so, we are to represent Christ everywhere we are. The distractions of the world and its love can make you lose interest in the things of Heaven. Do not let the pleasure of the world to take you off from the love of God.
2. Love of the world.
3. Shallow messages (Mark. 16:15): We are to go into all the world and preach the gospel but unfortunately we have many preachers who are teaching the diluted word of God, it is not supposed to be so.
4. Mixed multitude (Exo. 12:37-38): If you are not careful you may be distracted with the mixed multitude. We are not to allow the mixed multitude influence our focus on Christ.
5. Challenges of life (Matt. 3:11; 13-14): Challenges of life are inevitable but we are to be focused on Christ and not allow them distract us. John was a true follower of Christ but when he was faced with challenges of life he was asking if Jesus was the true messiah. Peter was also a true believer but he denied Jesus because he was faced with the challenges of life (Matt. 26:74).

\*We are not to be distracted, we are to be focused and not allow anything distract us from following Jesus.
