FROM THE PULPIT LAST SUNDAY 19/10/25 Topic: Hindrances to Fruitfulness & Multiplication: A Case Study of the Mad Man of Gadara Text: Matthew 13:22 & Luke 8:26-39 Speakers: Revd. Tope Olabode • God does not expect us to be resistant to the Word. He wants us to receive it as it comes to us. • We should receive, process and allow the word of God to have the expected impact on us rather than being influenced by our physical & social environment. We become fruitful when this happens. • If a man fails to receive the word of God, such a man will be a wild man and not fit for the kingdom of God. A life without Jesus is a wild life. • When a man has no word of God in him, he becomes a wandering man just like the mad man of Gadara. • Esau is another man to be mentioned amongst this category. He lived a wild life in the scriptures and sold his birth right as the first born for food. The Prodigal Son is also another example! Similarly, many still lives wild life. • The world is a wilderness of darkness; we need the word of God to shine on our path via life. • Jacob spent 21 years of wild life in his father-in-law's house just to marry. • The devil does not respect age or status, he’s only looking for any available vessel to use. • The devil only respects those who are on the Lord's side. Are you on the Lord's side? • Jesus is ready to deliver us from the unfruitful works of darkness as he did by delivering the Mad Man of Gadara. After delivering him, Jesus instructed him to go to his household and tell them what has happened to him. Herein he became fruitful. • A wild life is a thorny and a choked life, such is a life without Jesus. It is not until we get to heaven before we receive eternal life. It's right here on earth. OPERATION WORLD Greece Capital: Athens Greece has an estimated population of 11.3 million people. The Greek Constitution recognizes the Orthodox faith as the "prevailing" faith of the country, while guaranteeing freedom of religion for all. An estimated 97% of Greek citizens belong to the Greek Orthodox Church. Greece is receptive to the gospel and ready for revival. Let's pray that the door of evangelism that is opened will not be shut by sin, self and worldliness. Ask the Lord to send labourers into the land for a harvest of true disciples rather than church goers. Praying for Nigeria: Kaduna State Kaduna State has an estimated population of 8.3 million people. It comprises more than 60 tribal groups, e.g. Hausa, Gbagyi, Kadara, Kaje, Asholio, Kagoro Katab etc Though Islam is the dominant religion, Christianity is practiced by a significant proportion of the people with some indigenous religious adherents. Pray for the gospel light to beam across the length and breadth of Kaduna State and spread like wild fire.
