#### FROM THE PULPIT LAST SUNDAY 14/09/25

Topic: Offering Praise Text: Psalm 50:1-23

Speaker: Pastor Henry Owolabi

- We are to give praise to God in all situations, because those who do so are glorifying God (v23).
- It is not every praise that God accepts, so we should only be curious about what
  is acceptable to him, we should desire that ours should be acceptable to him.
- God does not reject the praises that are not offered from a genuine heart, his
  testimony is against those who offer such praises.
- Praise is rejected from those hate taking instructions from God, reject discipline and forget his words and ordinances (v17).
- God turns his back on those who befriend thieves.
- Believers must watch the character of their friends to ensure they are not adulterers if they want God to accept their praise.
- If any believer thinks he could say anything he likes with his mouth, plot or
  conceive deceit and yet desires to praise God, s/he will meet with rejection.
- We have to do away with accusing our relatives or finding fault with them if we
  desire that God should accept our praise.
- Thanksgiving is not just about giving money, it requires us to give ourselves to God.
- God is interested in those who take to His corrections and will accept their praise.
- We are to praise God at all times irrespective of their situation.
- · Praising God should be a lifestyle and not a seasonal thing.

#### **OPERATION WORLD**

#### Finland Capital: Helsinki

Finland has a population estimate of 5.4 million. Finnish and Swedish are the official languages of Finland. The best known foreign languages are English (63%), German (18%), and French (3%). There are approximately 4.2 million (or 78.2% at the end of 2010) adherents of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Finland, one of the largest Lutheran churches in the world.

Let us pray that the work of the Lord in the land will abide. Ask that the Finish people will not be nominal Christians but will identify with Jesus in life and character. Also, pray that the gospel will reach the younger generation.

### **Praying for Nigeria: Edo State**
