Topic: Lay Weights Aside To Be An Effective Ambassador Of Christ
Text: Hebrews 12: 1 – 2
Speakers: Pastor A. J. Abereoran

The Speaker Emphasized that:

- *We cannot represent Christ wholly if we do not know Him.
- *As an ambassador for Christ, we have our postings. Everywhere you find yourself, you are to represent Christ.
- *We are to lay aside everything that is hindering us from being effective ambassadors of Christ.
- *Sometimes we waste the resources we have to be a good ambassador for Christ.
- *Paul had good qualification to make him a successful man in life but he counted all he had gained as waste for him to be good ambassadors for Christ.
- *Effective ambassadors for Christ have to acknowledge that they are encompassed about with every crowd of witnesses (Heb. 12:1).
- *We are not to be looking at the crowd, we are not spectators, we are expected to be actors. No one can be a spectator in his own race.
- *Good ambassadors trust God in all things and focus on Jesus who has gone before them. They model Christ alone!
- *It is by looking unto Jesus that will make you become like Him.
- *Where ever we find ourselves, we are to be a good ambassador of Christ.
- *We are to lay aside every weight that will distract you from following Christ.
