**Topic:** As for You, Be Fruitful and Multiply

Text: Gen. 1:28; Gen. 9:7

- There is always a condition attached to being fruitful.
- The first condition is to abide in Jesus (John 15:4-5).
- Fruitfulness is only possible when we remain in Christ and abide in the Word of God that has been sown in our lives.
- · You will lose track with God if and when you move away from where God has positioned you, just like Ruth's husband did. (Ruth 1:1-2).
- The second condition to bear fruit is that you must be rooted in the Christ (Hebrew 10:25) and this is achieved through fellowship.
- Members of the Church of God, cannot grow or even become fruitful without the fellowshipping with other believers (Acts 2:42-47).
- The third condition to be fruitful is that you must be cooperate with and remain in unity with others to become as one with them (Psalm 133: 1-3).
- The fourth step to be fruitful is that we must maintain a consistent and constant walk with God just as Abraham did (Genesis 17: 1-2).
- Walking with God comes with blessings.

#### Denmark Capital: Copenhagen

Denmark's population is 5,475,791 with 80.4% of its people being members of the <u>Danish National Church</u>, a <u>Lutheran</u> church that was made the official state religion. Denmark's Muslims make up less than 2% of the population and form the country's second largest religious community. Religious societies and churches do not need official government recognition in Denmark. They can perform weddings and other ceremonies without this recognition.
